**Article Submission Guidelines for faculty members, master's, and postgraduate students:**

1. Upload one file to bafo-forum.ru.

The file name must include the author's full name.

**Example: Belova EV\_article.docx**

2. The file should include:

-The article text, containing the following information:

-UDC code

-Author's initials and surname (in alphabetical order)

-Article title

-Abstract and keywords (in Russian)

-List of references

-The same information in English:

- Article title
  - Author's initials and surname
  - Abstract and keywords
  - Author details: full name, academic degree, academic title, position, full name of institution, and contact details (email or phone number).
3. Article length: **8,000–13,000 characters** (including spaces, excluding author information, article title, and reference list).

**Attention: For graduate students, the article must be signed by their scientific supervisor with his/her degree, title, and full name (font 12 pt.).**

**Paper requirements:**

1. Page margins: 2 cm. Font: Times New Roman.
2. 14 pt – Full name (boldface font), title of the article (bold + uppercase), text of the article.
3. 12pt – UDC, Abstract, Keywords, List of Sources Used and Literature for references (boldface font + capital letters), including a phrase “Article presented by the scientific supervisor,...” and headings to the figures and tables.
4. Line spacing - single.Paragraph indent: 1.25 cm.
5. List numbering : manual (not automatic).
6. Automatic hyphenation throughout the text.
7. Left alignment: UDC.
8. Center alignment: title, full name, subtitles.
9. Width alignment: article text, reference list, abstract, keywords, author(s) details.
10. Page numbering: right bottom corner. Tables align to page width. Figures are centered in the text.
11. Each figure and table should have a number and heading and be in Microsoft Word format.
12. Footnotes for important information are made per page (don't refer to the reference list).

13. Should not use Latin letters, Greek and Russian alphabets; use your own macros and figure letters instead. Distinguish between the letter O and zero 0; sign, hyphen "-", en dash "-" and em dash "—".

14. The list of references is provided as a single general list at the end of the article. The list is compiled in the order of citation in the text, in accordance with GOST R 7.0.5-2008 "Bibliographic Reference." Citations to sources in the text are mandatory and must be enclosed in square brackets.

15. Article originality: no less than 80%.

**Articles will be checked for compliance with the requirements. Failure to comply with**

**the formal requirements is grounds for rejection of the article for publication in the**

**collection. The final decision to reject a manuscript for publication is made exclusively by the Editorial Board. The Editorial Board reserves the right to reject**

**materials for publication without explanation.**
